



Airport Info

Chicago-O'Hare International Airport (ORD)

Take Southbound Kennedy Expressway (190/94) to exit 52A- South Union Avenue/Roosevelt Road. Turn left at the second stoplight at Roosevelt Road. Drive 1 mile to Wabash Avenue then turn left heading north to the fourth stop light, then turn left, heading north to the fourth stop light, which is Balbo Drive. Turn right, heading east, and the hotel parking garage entrance will be on your right.

Distance from Hotel: 18 mi. | Drive Time: 45 min.

Chicago Midway Airport (MDW)

I-55 North to Chicago. North on Lakeshore Drive. West on Balbo. The hotel is 2 blocks down on the left.

Distance from Hotel: 12 mi. | Drive Time: 25 min.
